What To Pack:

As a Member of a chapter attending Convention I agree that:

- I will participate in all aspects of the program and to follow the daily schedule.
- I will conduct myself appropriately at all assemblies and activities.
- I will be challenged to have fun and participate in Leadership activities.
- I am representing my chapter and my school, and I will conduct myself accordingly.
- I will show respect towards other members, advisors, chaperones, and staff.
- I will follow instructions from ANY advisor, adult supervisor, or staff.
- I will not bring or use any form of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs.
- I will wear appropriate clothing (covering the body from the shoulders to mid-thigh) at all times.

- I will wear an appropriate one piece swim suit suitable for leadership camp.
- I will not enter any rooms that are housing members of the opposite sex.
- I will be in my assigned room after curfew.
- I will not participate in any act of violence. I understand that acts of violence will not be tolerated and that firearms and weapons, including knives, are prohibited at leadership events.
- Any use of inappropriate language, conduct, or harassment is prohibited at leadership events

Failure to meet with these standards will result in these steps:

1. I may be asked to call my parents/guardians and report my conduct not in compliance with these guidelines.
2. At the Advisor's discretion, this may result in parents/guardians arranging transportation home.
3. Inappropriate conduct will result in forfeiting any leadership points or awards.
